

Terms & Conditions of Entry to

Sorry NO PETS due to the wildlife

Please proceed to *Office/House* to check-in and pay. If the office is unattended please use the radio on the veranda and call us.

Late arrivals and early check-outs please use the honesty system and leave money under the office door.

Vehicle access on driveway and campgrounds only. 5 kph inside the park, 15 kph (no dust) on driveway.

One fire only in the designated area with firewood we provide. No firewood collection on the property. Adhere to current local fire restrictions.

No Loud Noise after 9pm.

Children must be supervised at all times.

Bustard Downs has a no hunting & gathering policy. Catch & release fishing with barbless hooks is accepted.

No Littering, rubbish to be placed in bins provided.

Cigarette butts must be put out and disposed of in a bin, we consider butts on the ground as littering and a fire hazard.

Trail/Quad bike riders are welcome to camp on Bustard Downs, however trail/Quad bike riding is not allowed on Bustard Downs private property or Riparian zone.

Bustard Downs has a no tolerance policy on violence, aggressive, or excessive drunken behaviour and reserve the right to refuse entry or evict offending person/s immediately.

Campers, Caravaners, Motor home guest have access to our campground and Riparian zone by the Mary Creek, & listed walk areas on map. Please respect our's and our neighbours private property & privacy. As an example, crossing the main channel of the Mary Creek you would no longer be on Bustard Downs property but one of our neighbours.

Guests and day visitors to Bustard Downs enter at their own risk at all times. Bustard Downs and its owners cannot accept responsibility or liability for theft, loss or injury including loss of life whilst on Bustard Downs property under any circumstances.

Should you not agree to these terms and conditions, you are not permitted to enter Bustard Downs property.
